

Supplement to the Privacy Statement

This document serves as a supplement to the privacy statement of Meijers Assurantiën.

Scope

These provisions apply to all processing of personal data carried out by Meijers Assurantiën, Meijers Assuradeuren, Meijers Services, and Meijers Vitaal. Meijers Assurantiën complies with all applicable privacy laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the Financial Supervision Act (Wft), and the Code of Conduct for the Processing of Personal Data by Financial Institutions, as well as any other relevant codes of conduct and guidelines. The same commitment applies to Meijers Assuradeuren, Meijers Services, and Meijers Vitaal.

Why do we process your personal data?

Meijers Assurantiën processes personal data and may share it with Meijers Assuradeuren, Meijers Services, and Meijers Vitaal for the following purposes:

- To provide services related to an insurance product or service arranged through Meijers Assurantiën and delivered by Meijers Services and/or Meijers Vitaal.
- To deliver occupational health and safety services, reintegration services, or consultancy services following a report received by Meijers Assurantiën within the scope of the relevant insurance or service agreement.
- To analyze personal data to improve our product and service offerings and to better align them with the needs of (potential) clients.

In addition to the data provided directly by you, Meijers Assurantiën may, where legally permitted, obtain data from reliable external sources such as (but not limited to) the Dutch Employee Insurance Agency (UWV) or the Tax and Customs Administration. Meijers Assurantiën ensures that all personal data processed is accurate, relevant, adequate, and not excessive.

What personal data do we process?

Meijers Assurantiën may process and share the following categories of personal data with Meijers Assuradeuren, Meijers Services, and Meijers Vitaal:

- Contact details (e.g. name, address, place of residence, telephone number, email address);
- Date of birth, gender, marital status;
- Identification details (e.g. passport, driving license, or other proof of identity);
- Employment information (e.g. employer, profession, position, income);
- Financial product information (e.g. bank account numbers, insurance policies);
- Special categories of personal data, such as health-related data;
- Information on social support benefits (e.g. Wajong, Wazo);
- Details of workplace accidents or third-party recovery options;
- Information related to benefit entitlements (e.g. decisions from the UWV);
- Data concerning any criminal or fraudulent activity;
- Claims data, including submitted claims and claims history.

Personal data is processed solely for the purposes for which it was collected and is only accessible to individuals who require it to perform their duties and deliver services.
